California Car Detailing Business License Checklist

- 1. Choose and register your business structure (LLC, Corporation, Sole Proprietorship, etc.).
- 2. File a Fictitious Business Name (DBA) if using a trade name.
- 3. Apply for a Federal EIN from the IRS.
- 4. Register with the California Secretary of State (for LLCs/corporations).
- 5. Apply for Car Wash & Polishing Registration with the DIR.
- 6. Prepare required documents: formation papers, EIN, insurance proof, tax forms.
- 7. Obtain a \$150,000 surety bond (or qualify for an exemption).
- 8. Pay the \$300 annual registration fee per location.
- 9. Post your registration certificate in a visible spot.
- 10. Keep records for at least three years.
- 11. Renew your registration annually.
- 12. For mobile detailers: check local zoning, water use, and waste disposal rules.
